EASTER SEASON (April 8 - May 27, 2012)

The seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost are celebrated as on great feast day. St. Athanasius called them "the great Sunday." Christians sing the "Alleluia" during these days in their rejoicing.

The Easter season, known in the early Church as the "Great Sunday" or "the Fifty Days" continues the Church's celebration of the Lord's Paschal Mystery: Jesus' suffering, death, resurrection, ascension and sending of the Spirit are celebrated as one event in God's plan of salvation. Pentecost concludes the Easter season and cycle; Ordinary Time resumes until the following Advent." (from "Ordo") - Liturgical Calendar

Mass celebrated by the parish community represents the universal Church in a given time in a special way of Eucharist on the Lord's Day, the original Christian feast.

DIVINE MERCY

The Second Sunday of Easter bears this extended title. We celebrate God's divine mercy every Sunday, and particularly throughout Easter Time, as we proclaim the Pascal Mystery. This aspect of our faith sits at the centre of our tradition and should be the focus of the Easter liturgy.

Divine Mercy Mass will be celebrated at Sacred Heart Cathedral today, April 15th. Main celebrant: Bishop David Monroe. Confessions: 1:30 - 2:30 PM, Chaplet of Divine Mercy: 2:30 PM and Mass at 3:00 PM.

*** The Sacrament of Reconciliation**

Wednesday 5:30 - 6:30 PM and Saturday 9:30 - 10:30 AM

For those wishing the plenary indulgence associated with this devotion Blessed Pope John Paul II said at Sr. St. Faustina's canonization (2000)"

FROM THE TWO TABLES: WORD AND EUCHARIST

For most of us, the betrayal of friends is a grievous hurt, whether it is deliberate or the result of fear and weakness on their part. When friends betray us, it hurts and sometimes festers, causing resentments and alienation. What a model Jesus is in today's Gospel! There is no "pound of flesh" required. There is no blaming. There is no demeaning remark, just a simple "Peace be with you" (John 20:19). One of the proofs of identity of a follower of Jesus is that person's capacity to forgive no matter what. Forgiveness is a freeing experience. It unbinds people. It does what Jesus did; proclaims the Good News. It identifies us a true disciple. (LTP - p.190)
