DAYCARE AND PRE-SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The new St. Ann's Childcare Centre will be offering three different programs for children ages 2 1/2 - 12 years, including a licensed Daycare with 20 new spaces.

The Daycare, expected to open in June is for children between the ages 2 1/2 and 5 years, and will be open weekdays from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm, all year long.

A new Preschool program, with space for 18 children, opens in September with a morning program [8:45 to 11:45 am] during the 10-month school year for children between the ages of 2 1/2 and 5 years.

The Before & After School program for children between the ages of 5 and 12 years, runs from 7:00 - 8:30 am and 2:30-5:30 pm during the regular school year. and 7:00 am to 5:30 pm during the summer months. this program has only a few spaces open at this time.
