**CISKD POSITIONS**

The central office of the Catholic Independent Schools of the Kamloops District require candidates to fill a number of part-time positions for the 2015-2016 school year, from September 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. As a Catholic school system, Catholic teachings are integrated into all aspects of the day-to-day administration of the system, therefore candidates who actively practice their faith are highly valued. **Part-Time Administrative Support Person:**

This position is part-time, consisting of approx. ten (10) hours per week. Will include but not be limited to: filing, archiving of files and assisting the central bookkeeper of CISKD as needed with daily administrative duties. Experience with office administration and bookkeeping is greatly valued.

**Part-Time Technology Support:**

Responsible for : maintenance of school and diocesan websites. Providing support for the Destiny-Follett library system for five schools. Providing support for the Moodle learning platform. The candidate would work remotely and from the offices of CISKD, with travel to the various schools as needed. Approx. 14 hours per week.

**District Library Support Person:**

Part-time position, consisting of approx. five (5) hours per week. Experience working with the Destiny/Follett library database is required. Would be responsible for assisting the schools of CISKD with the operation of their libraries and providing support for the ongoing professional development for school library technicians. The successful candidate would work remotely and from the offices of CISKD.

**Special Projects Coordinator**

To assist the schools of CISKD with the practice and training of staff with the Violence Threat Risk Assessment (VTRA) of ERASE bullying/safe Schools together. Work with the school based teams to assist them in understanding and implementing VTRA effectively in their school communities. Assist schools

in developing connections with the local representatives of the RCMP, Fire and Ambulance as well as the Ministry For Child and Family Development, Child and Youth Mental Health, and Aboriginal Child and Family Services .

Working with school principals to schedule drill practices with First Responders and debriefing after drills

Assisting the school principals with communication to school families regarding the emergency procedures in place at their schools.

Assisting school principals in the coordination of a crisis management team to deal with crisis situations.

\* Experience working in a school setting as a teacher and administrator

\* The ability to collaborate with teachers, support staff, administrators, students, families and representatives from outside agencies

\* Knowledge of the Ministry of Education's "Emergency Management Planning Guide for Schools and School Districts" and Safe Schools Together/ERASE bullying initiatives

\* Ability to use technology to communicate and coordinate meetings

\* Ability to travel to schools of CISKD at least twice a year to meet with school staffs.

This is a part-time position, consisting of approx. five (5) hours per week from September 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016. Travel and accommodation expenditures will be included to a maximum amount for the year.
