THINK ABOUT IT

No human being dies in a social vacuum. Consider how other people will be impacted by assisted suicide and euthanasia. What about the impact on the person who is responsible for ending someone's life.

All persons deserve protection against discrimination, but especially those who are vulnerable and may not have a voice, including those living with disabilities, mental illness, or dementia. Allowing assisted suicide and euthanasia entrenches the idea that some lives are not worth living.

Elder abuse and neglect is already a problem in society. This abuse and neglect could eventually include pressure to request euthanasia or assisted suicide, thus becoming the duty to die.
