### **Mikkie's Corner - Health & Nutrition**

Celebration! It is normal, fun and healthy to celebrate with a feast. However, most of the time we just overdo it. Here's some Easter survival tricks to get you through!

1. Use a smaller plate - you will fill it up just the same, but with less food and it tricks your brain into thinking your body is fuller faster.
2. Have only half a bun and cut desserts into 1/4's (so you can try a little of everything or a bit of something)
3. Fill plate with mostly protein and veggies and small amount of carbohydrates.
4. Drink a glass of water in-between "drinks" it will make your head feel better and you won't drink as much.
5. Exercise - march on the spot, do squats or lunges on the spot while preparing food, or go for a walk!
