Saint - John Vianney, Priest Aug. 04th

Born at Lyons in 1786. After overcoming many difficulties, he was ordained a priest. Entrusted with a parish in the town of Ars in the diocese of Belley, he cared for it in a marvelous way by his preaching, mortification, prayer and good works. Since he was renowned for great skill in helping penitents, people came to him from many regions and devoutly accepted his counsels. He died in 1859
