St. Gregory The Great 540-604

Born at Rome, he rose through various public offices to the prefecture which he renounced. He entered the monastic life and, once ordained deacon, he discharged the duties of legate at Constantinople. On Sept. 3, 590 he was elevated to the Chair of St. Peter and he proved to be a true shepherd by carrying out his office, helping the poor, spreading and strengthening the faith. He wrote extensively on moral and theological subjects.
