





Mikkies Corner, Health & Nutrition:

COMING BACK FROM INJURY....

Discussing a plan with your Health professional, verifying recommendations and understanding/clarifying the prescribed route for you, is extremely important. With being a Personal Trainer over the past 20 years, the worst pieces of advice that people were given or misunderstood, that I witnessed were:

- 1. Too not move and in-turn, have immobilized themselves for weeks or months, causing scar tissue to build up creating rigidness, weakness, stiffness, an array of new problems and even surgery that could've been avoided.
- 2. Abusing medication prescribed, becoming reliant then having to add different meds to stop an undesirable side affect from one med, too having to increase or have stronger meds because one or more no longer seem to be effective. This is a viscous cycle you do not want to get on.
- 3. Too much too fast. This is pretty obvious, as you will injure yourself more, create new problems or delay recovery significantly.


