**Mikkies Corner, Health & Nutrition:**  
*COMING BACK FROM INJURY...*

Continuing from last week and knowing/ understanding a plan is key. Rehabbing myself back means not pushing too fast but also moving as much and as safely as I can, not relying on but balancing medication. Medication is important and has its place for sure but knowing, understanding pros/cons of what the medication is doing is also important. For my type of injury, meds prescribed is pretty standard;

1. Anti-inflammatory's-help control pain by taking away inflammation, but also restricts nutrient rich blood to the affected area that helps with healing.
2. Muscle relaxants-help control pain and stops spasms but masks what you are capable of, so you might overdo it or rely on it.

Taking medication wisely and other things I am doing to rehab myself back with specific exercises.... to be cont....
