Weight where it matters!

Did you know that where you put weight on matters? Researchers of CDC (Center for Disease Control) gauge the highest obesity-related health risk based on the size of one's waist circumference: The larger the waist size, the higher the health risk. Men & women tend to put weight on in different places. Women accumulate fat mainly on breasts, hips & thighs. Men accumulate fat around their waist, which unfortunately is a dangerous spot. Waist fat makes its way to the liver where problems start to happen faster, diabetes, hypertension, heart disease, cancer & sleep apnea. But ladies don't let that fool you if you have extra pounds, both men & women are at risk for heart disease & cancer being the top 2 followed by stroke, diabetes & Alzheimer's. The good news is these all can be mitigated through your diet - what you eat!
