MIKKIE'S CORNER - Health & Nutrition

Tips to make your New Year's Resolutions stick!

Set realistic goals. Many people set great goals of improving health in the New Year and fall short, by setting too high of expectations.

- 1.) Get back to, or start, scheduled healthy eating by either having 3 square meals a day if not that much activity or 3 meals and 2 - 3 snacks in between meals.
- 2.) Eat every 2-3 hours don't wait longer than 4 hours between meals or snacks.
- 3.) Make breakfast or lunch your biggest meals and Dinner try not to make too heavy in fats or Simple Carbohydrates. A lean protein with small amount of a Complex Carbs like yam, sweet potato or brown rice, a large salad filled with a variety of vegetables and a vinaigrette type dressing is ideal. Snacks make them higher in good fats as plain nuts, avocado, or dark chocolate at least 72% or higher.
- 4.) Get moving! Don't get crazy if you haven't done much exercise previously. A good way to start, if new to exercise, is put on a half hour program on your TV and march in the spot adding in some high knees or squats here and there for the full half hour. It's easy and you will be distracted by your program to even notice you did a full 30 minutes.
