MIKKIE'S CORNER - Health & Nutrition

Building stronger bones!

Continuing this series of building stronger bones is the mineral Magnesium, which is one of the most important links in this series. Magnesium assures the strength and firmness of bones and makes teeth harder, it supports bone health, by stimulating the thyroid's production of a bone-preserving hormone calcitonin, by drawing calcium out of the blood and soft tissues back into the bones.

The Vit D connection: Magnesium is necessary for the conversion of Vit D into its active form and a deficiency can lead to a Vit D resistance. Similarly high doses of Vit D and if already low in magnesium, then magnesium gets drained from muscle storage where deficiency symptoms develop; twitching, leg cramps, restless legs, charlie horses and even more serious conditions as , angina or heart attacks, as the heart is a muscle.

The Calcium connection: Magnesium and Calcium work so closely together, that a deficiency in one drastically affects the other. In fact increasing calcium supplementation without an increase in magnesium will cause magnesium loss, or if already deficient can lead to arthritis and kidney stones. Magnesium is needed for activation of an enzyme that is required for forming new calcium crystals, *alkaline phosphatase*, and if low in magnesium then abnormal bone crystal formation can result. Even mild magnesium deficiency is reported to be a leading risk factor for osteoporosis..

How much Magnesium should you be taking in and summing up building stronger bones to be continued next week....

What is Serra?

The Serra International Foundation was founded in 1951 to assist Serra in fulfilling its objectives of fostering and promoting vocations in the Catholic Church. Since that time, the Foundation has funded a wide range of programs for the formation and training of priests and consecrated religious. Serra International is not a fundraising organization. Its primary methods are prayer and action. The Foundation's role is to support and complement those methods, not to eclipse them. Since 1967 - the beginning of the downturn in vocations - the Foundation's role has increased in significance and importance. Since then, in the United States, there has been an estimated 20% decrease in the number of active priests. Some projections that take into account the numbers of retired priests who remain in service estimate that the decrease is closer to 35%. During this same period, the Catholic population has grown, causing the number of Catholics per active priest to increase by about 60%. Moreover, it is estimated that within the next fifteen years, half of all priests serving today will have retired.
