MIKKIE'S CORNER - Health & Nutrition

Weight loss Metabolism boosting products

Studies also show that vinegar can help you lose weight. Several human studies show that vinegar can increase satiety, help you eat fewer calories and lead to actual pounds lost on the scale. For example, if people take vinegar along with a high-carb meal, they get increased feelings of fullness and end up eating 200-275 fewer calories for the rest of the day. Another study in Japan undertaken by the Central Research Institute there, conducted a double-blind 12 week trial on obese Japanese subjects. The subjects in each group ingested 500 ml daily of a beverage containing either 15 ml of vinegar, 30 ml of vinegar, or 0 ml of vinegar, usually taken in eight ounces of water. The results of the study revealed body weight, BMI, visceral fat area, waist circumference, and serum triglyceride levels were significantly lower in both vinegar intake groups than in the placebo group. This does appear to be a weight loss aid by, promoting satiety, lowering blood sugar and insulin levels. But like all products it won't work miracles on its own, exercise and balanced diet are always key to the success of its benefits.
