## Sept 27, feast day for St. Vincent de Paul,



The patron of all charitable societies was born to a poor peasant family in the French village of Pouy on Apr 24, 1581. After he was ordained in 1600 he spent his life providing relief to and preaching missions to the poor. He later extended his concern and ministry to convicts. The need to evangelize and assist these souls was so great that he founded the Ladies of Charity, a lay institute of woman, as well as a religious institute of priests in a time when there were not many priests in France and the priests that were there were neither well-formed nor faithful to their way of life. He had reformed them to create the Congregation of Priests of the Mission, referred to now as the Vincentians, which remain today with nearly 4,000 members in 86 countries. In addition to this order, St. Vincent cofounded, the Daughters of Charity, with St. Louise de Marillac. There are more than 18,000 Daughters today serving the needs of the poor in 94 countries. St. Vincent died on Sept 27, 1660 at 80 years old. He is sometimes referred to as "The Apostle of Charity" and "The Father of the Poor". He is attributed to 2 miracles - 1) A nun cured of ulcers. 2)A laywoman cured of paralysis. As a result of the 1st, Pope Benedict XIII beatified him on Aug 13, 1729 and on Jun 16, 1737, he was canonized by Pope Clement XIII. The Bull of Canonization recognized Vincent for his charity and reform of the clergy, as well as for his early role in opposing Jansenism.
