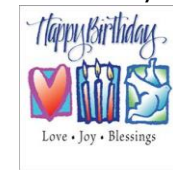

**MIKKIE'S CORNER - Health & Nutrition**

*New Year's Resolution continued!*

Continuing from last week; New Year's Resolutions in regards to diet and exercise. Did you know just 30 minutes of walking a day can make significant changes in Blood Pressure, Cholesterol, Heart Rate...along with a variety of other benefits. Last week I wrote about not setting too high expectations and to start out slowly. Well I have an easy challenge for those that are just starting out or coming back to exercise. I want you to commit to a 6 week challenge not on the scale but on your insides! Here is the challenge:

- 1) Take what you can measure Blood Pressure (BP) & Pulse - any local drug store usually has a machine.
- 2) Walk 30 minutes a day everyday try to make it a brisk walk, if too slippery outside march on the spot at home. Guide you intensity on how hot you get if you have couple layers on that top layer should feel warm enough to take off.
- 3) Then 6 weeks later take BP & Pulse again. The benefits we don't see can actually be the most crucial and life saving.
