New Year's Resolution continued!

Continuation to a healthier New Year's with recipes, that are healthy, fast and easy to prepare: This week is lunch, high fiber when lots of veggies added. Sandwiches/wraps made easy.

Fat Free or Low Fat version

Lettuce wrap with any lean meat (tuna, chicken, turkey) of choice and any veggies of choice. Condiments to use if desired hummus, tzatziki, mustard low fat mayonnaise, hot sauce, pepper.

Balanced carbs, fat, protein version:

Do the same as above with a high fiber bread like (squirrely bread) use salmon or add avocado, hemp or chia seeds for a bit of healthy fat content.

Higher Fat keto style version:

Same as balanced carb fat protein version minus the bread.
