*New Year's Resolution continued!*

Recipes, that are healthy, fast and easy to prepare: This week dinner, high fiber - Chilli!

#### **Fat Free or Low Fat version**

1 can whole or chopped tomatoes with juice and 1 750 beef broth. Chopped green peppers (2) 1 large onion, 1 lb ground turkey, 1 can kidney beans, 1/4 cup chilli spice fresh crushed garlic 1 tbsp or more. Cook turkey first then combine all in a pot bring to boil then simmer. If it is too spicy add 1/4-1/2 cup of plain fat free yogurt. This is already pretty balanced but add whole wheat bun or ryvita crisps with a tsp butter for a bit more carb and fat.
