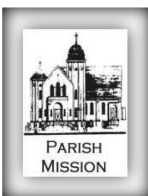

Solemnity of St. Joseph - March 19, 2019

Message of Prayer and Solidarity:

To the People of the Dioceses of Kamloops,

Our Hearts have called us to respond to the shooting of our innocent Muslim brothers and sisters in New Zealand last week while in prayer their place of worship.

This act of unspeakable violence is a terrible evil against justice and truth. Justice concerning the right of safety and respect of every human being. Truth that their injury and death is caused by an act of evil that needs to be condemned as violence against the very dignity of our humanity.
