Weekly Environmental Tip - Consider your sunscreen

Sunscreens are confusing enough and now many are causing damage to coral reefs and aquatic life with all the chemicals they have associated with them. In July 2018, Hawaii became the first U.S. state to ban the sale of sunscreens containing two common chemicals, oxybenzone and octinoxate, which many researchers worldwide have deemed potentially harmful to aquatic life, Florida is next to follow suit. There are reef free sunscreens without these ingredients but the impact of other chemicals are not known yet and are currently not highly regulated. The best option is covering up with clothing or under an umbrella from the sun but if this is not an option the reef free sunscreen would be a better option than other sunscreens as at least the 2 most harmful chemicals are omitted.

MIKKIE'S CORNER - Health & Nutrition

Vegetarianism (not wacky but can be, if done incorrectly).
Either vegetarian or non-vegetarian, the following groups are at risk for inadequate intakes of iron, with vegetarians having to be even more diligent:

Pregnant women: Plasma volume & red cell mass expand due to dramatic increases in red blood cell production.

Infants & Young Children: Especially preterm or low birth-weight or if mother was low during pregnancy. Full term infants with non-deficient mother will have sufficient stores until 6 mos then can become deficient if they do not obtain solid foods rich in bioavailable iron (ie formula or continue with breast milk)

Women with menstrual bleeding: Especially women with menorrhagia (abnormally heavy bleeding) lose significantly more iron than their counterparts

Frequent blood donors, donating as often as every 8 weeks can deplete built up iron stores

People with gastrointestinal disorders or have these type surgeries results in iron malabsorption because of dietary restrictions with these conditions

Aging population - digestion can become compromised and absorbability of nutrients is harder.
