Referring back to Aug 25 bulletin regarding plastic recyclable products and understanding the terminology along with what are the best practices? We looked at Bio-or plant-based, Bio-plastic and Degradable. All sounding very responsible for consumers that are looking to help out with their carbon footprint. However these didn't turn up to be the best solutions for different reasons. As technology is quickly advancing and developing better options, for now the best practice is to look for plant-based plastics that are recyclable (rather than compostable, or "biodegradable"

#### **Importance of Iodine!**

Iodine is a mineral the body needs to make thyroid hormones. These hormones are especially important for controlling the body's metabolism and for proper bone/brain development during pregnancy and infancy. Foods highest in iodine are: Seaweed, dairy, tuna, shrimp and eggs. If you are Vegan the good news is it is abundant in different seaweeds. If you don't like Seaweed, not all is lost as iodized salt is another way to make sure you are getting it in, but doing so carefully.
