MIKKIE'S CORNER - Health & Nutrition Importance of Iodine!

Not a lot of iodine is needed but is essential and actually very limited in some areas of the world especially inland areas where there is little to no iodine in the soil. Amazingly 1.5 billion people are still deficient. Recommended daily intake (RDI) for iodine is measured in micrograms (mcg, or µg):
younger children (1 to 8 years) – 90 mcg
older children (9 to 13 years, boys and girls) – 120 mcg
adolescents (14 to 18 years) – 150 mcg
men – 150 mcg
women – 150 mcg
during pregnancy and breastfeeding – 220 mcg and 270 mcg respectively.
