**Monounsaturated Fatty Acids (MUFA)**

Best Choices for Omega-9 Essential Fatty Acids (Oleic Acid) While Omega-9 is not technically classified as an essential fatty acid because our bodies can manufacture it –however foods rich in oleic acid are recommended because oleic acid assists in cancer protection, and decreases the risk of heart attacks and arteriosclerosis. These would also be the oils to cook with as they can cook at high heat without turning into trans fats.
