THE SANCTUARY COURSE FOR CATHOLICS

Would you like to discover what God, Scripture, and Church have to say of the experiences of mental health challenges, and join others in a conversation about mental health? Sign up for The Sanctuary Course for Catholics with *Adele Huculak, Registered Clinical Counsellor*.

This course is an eight-part course designed to raise awareness and start conversations regarding mental health. It was created along with Catholic mental health professionals, theologians, and clergy, and offers faith communities the chance to learn about mental health and grow in their ability to support members living with mental health challenges. Topics covered include: mental health and mental illness, stigma, recovery, companionship, self-care, and community.

The sessions involve films that feature the stories of Catholics living with mental health challenges, along with the insights of archbishops, theologians, and psychologists. The course is available to download as a PDF or as an audiobook. It is recommended that you read/listen to the sessions in advance of meeting.
