## Preparation of the Solemnity Feast of St. Joseph Principal Patron of Canada

Pope Francis has proclaimed this year as the "Year of St. Joseph", recognizing the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. Bishop Joseph is asking the faithful of our Diocese to prepare for the Solemnity Feast of St. Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church and Canada, on March 19<sup>th</sup> by praying a novena prayer each day from **March 10 - March 18** inclusive; the novena will be **livestreamed** each morning at **11:30 am** in community prayer from Sacred Heart Cathedral in Kamloops, along with a very short teaching each day about the life of St. Joseph.

On **March 19**, Bishop Joseph will celebrate Mass commemorating the Solemnity Feast of St. Joseph at Sacred Heart Cathedral; this Mass will be **livestreamed** beginning at **11:30 am**. Please mark your calendars for these livestreams.

Protect, O Holy Guardian, this our nation.

Enlighten those responsible for the common good, so that they might know – like you do – how to care for those entrusted to their responsibility.

Grant intelligence of knowledge to those seeking adequate means for the health and physical well-being of their brothers and sisters.
