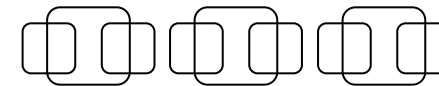

Surviving Thanksgiving Dinner.....

Enjoy your dinner without the bloating and exhaustion that sometimes comes with it.

- 1) Choose a smaller plate. The saying "Your eyes are bigger than your stomach," is true. We will eat what we see. If you fill a smaller plate, the brain will perceive it just the same as a full big plate & leave you satisfied & full but not overdone.
- 2) Take half a bun instead of a whole bun
- 3) Load up on the veggies and less potato
- 4) Take a mix of white & dark meat, oddly enough there isn't a huge caloric difference. White meat may be slightly less in fat but dark meat consists of more Vit. B6, B12, iron, zinc, riboflavin & Thiamin. So having a mix will be more satisfying & may stop you from loading up on other food or globs of gravy & or cranberry sauce. Don't indulge - ENJOY!
