7.) Pump Iron: Ingest and incorporate weight bearing exercises. Adequate iron intake is important, like last week with zinc, iron levels are directly related to those NK (natural killer cells) that help detect and kill cancer cells. Best food sources are: clams, soybeans, lentils & spinach. With exercise it is important to use appropriate resistance or weight bearing exercise. The results of increased circulation, reduced stress & increased body temperature all improve immune system.

8.) Vitamin E - Low levels of Vit E are associated with tumor development & infections. It is an efficient antioxidant & modulator of the immune system so make sure you are getting it in. Best food sources are: sunflower seeds, almonds, tomato paste & spinach.

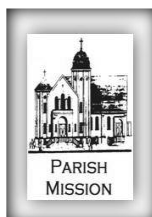
