COVID 19 PROTOCOLS

This is how we are going follow the procedure as you come to the Church.

1. Arrive for Mass just 15 minutes early.
2. Everyone is strongly recommended to bring and wear a mask.
3. Please bring your own wipes and hand sanitizer.
4. Weather permitting - 1st Greeting to take place outside and a volunteer greeter (wearing mask and glove) will squirt hand sanitizer onto Parishioner and opens the door to enter.
5. 2nd Greeting - will take attendance - write Parishioner name, Address and contact information by asking the wellness questionnaire
6. There will not be a collection plate handed around – please put your donation in the box kept near the entrance before or after Mass.
7. Ushers will advise Parishioner to sit in pew where 2 meter taped markings are. Families sitting together is fine but others seated beside the family must find a 2 meter marker from the family or sit in another pew.
8. The ushers will be using only side doors to enter the church. The main door will be open only for the main celebrant of the mass.
9. There will be only one reader to proclaim the word of God (Introduction, 1st reading, Psalm and 2nd reading)
10. Deacon Eddie will read the intentions
11. During the sign of peace you can wave or nod at your neighbors as hand shaking has been suspended
12. Communion procession - following 2 metre markings on the floor, the Eucharistic ministers (wearing mask and face shield) will lightly drop the Eucharist into the receiver's hand, in the event that the Minister touches a person, he/she will immediately hand sanitize before the next person
13. Parishioners will move back to their pew and stay standing for final prayer and dismissal.
14. Exit single file 2 metre distance through propped open door.
15. We discourage the use of restrooms unless it is an emergency
16. Volunteers will spray disinfect and sanitize pews and wipe down doors knobs after the mass
17. The choir will be limited to musician and a singer. There will be no hymnals or missals in the pews. We will try to use LCD projector to display the words in future Sundays.
18. No social gatherings before or after Mass
19. No Children's Liturgy. Keeping young children to observe social distancing is too difficult.

We thank you for your cooperation with the new protocols as we learn this temporary normal for our parish community to return to Church. These protocols also apply to daily Mass and are subject to change. If we are patient and prayerful we will get through this. May God bless each of you and keep you safe.
